GOLF CARTS:

There have been several complaints about pets not being kept on a leash. You are required to keep your pet on a leash and under control at all times. Be considerate of others and their sites and take your pet to the pet walk area to do their business. **Be sure to pick up after them when they use your site or someone else's site and at the dog walk.** Complementary pickup bags are at the dog walk, parkway and picnic area, if you have forgotten your own bags.

ELECTRIC BILL

The next electric bill will be ready for pick up Labor Day weekend, September 1. The final reading will be after the park closes October 15.

CAMP FIRE SAFTY:

As the weather gets cooler we will see more campfires. Please alert the whole family about campfire safety.

1. Always use a portable fire pit.
2. Never use gasoline to start a fire.
3. Do not get the fire too large so that it would damage a car or trailer with flames or sparks.
4. Do not have your fire pit to close to your neighbor's trailer.
5. After the ashes cool, scoop them into a trash bag for disposal. DO NOT put the cold or hot ashes on the ground. Never put hot ashes in the dumpsters.

RECYCLE TO BE GREEN

Thanks to everyone who contribute to the recycling program. Just a reminder that all of the black bins by the dumpsters are for all recycles. They all end up in the same container. Please **NO**

plastic bags of any kind. Enjoy the rest of your summer. Thank you from the maintenance staff.

BOATS STORED IN RV PARK

Please get approval from the Resort Manager before storing a boat or boat lift for the winter on your space. The stored equipment must be able to fit within your actual space. This will include the area in front of your RV unit as long as the stored equipment does not sit out on the street or on your neighbor's space. The Marina winter storage fee will be charged for any boat, boat lift or pwc lift stored in the RV Park.

We have noticed more engine running problems this year due to water in the gas tank. Road gas with ethanol will cause water to condense in the gas tank. If you do not use the ethanol free gas and are having some running

problems with your engine, check for water in the bottom of the gas tank. We sell 90 octane ethanol free boat gas.

Our service department is ready to keep your boat in top running condition. If you need to sell a boat, please stop by our sales department to set up your boat on consignment. If you are buying a used boat from an individual, bring it in for a fifty point inspection so that you will know of any problems in advance.
