### BEACH SAFETY

Beach safety is each family's responsibility. Please accompany your child to the beach. There is no lifeguard on duty at the beach; however there is emergency equipment for the beach on the southeast corner of the beach store. An emergency telephone is on the southwest corner of the store.

### SEWERS:

Please do not put tampons, baby wipes, and disposable wipes in the toilets. They can clog the septic lines. If they clog, it could affect several units.

### PARK SECURITY

Park security is a joint effort. Even though we are a very safe RV park, it is always a good idea to take precautions. Keep poles and tackle out of sight if you leave equipment in your boat. Lock car and trailer doors when you go out on the lake. Watch out for your neighbor and have your neighbor watch out for you. Please report suspicious activity to the Resort Office.
